The objective of the SUSTAIN network is to develop IBSE-oriented educators and teachers' continuing professional development (CPD), classroom activities and resources for Education for Sustainable Development (ESD).

To reach this goal, the network will use and disseminate effective and well-tried methods of science teaching, in particular IBSE, a method that the partners have also already begun to link with citizenship, ethics and responsibility issues.

The SUSTAIN network is divided into three topic groups: Energy, Food in ESD & Everyday Objects, each working on CPD contents and resources.

In the frame of this project and as a result of the work and exchanges between the Sustain partners, **3 European professional development sessions are organised from September 2015 to December 2015** on the following topics:
