**GIFT-2019** will take place in Vienna, **April 8-10, 2019**, during the General Assembly of the European Geosciences Union. It will be preceded on Sunday, **April 7**, by a guided visit to the splendid Vienna Natural History Museum, one of the most renowned in the world.

The theme of our workshop this year is « **Plate tectonics and earth's structure – yesterday, today, tomorrow** ». Over two and a half days, the workshop will explore the major processes and structures of plate tectonics and our planet, through topical presentations from scientists at the cutting-edge of research, together with hands-on teaching activities, following the tradition of GIFT workshops.

Teachers are also invited on a voluntary basis, to present classroom strategies and activities that they may have developed with their pupils in the poster session « Science in future Classrooms » which is an integral part of the GIFT workshop.
